ITEM 1 – PUBLIC COMMENT

ITEM 2 – HISTORIC PRESERVATION INCENTIVES INCLUDING THE MILLS ACT PROGRAM

Staff will present information on current and proposed historic preservation incentives, including the existing Mills Act program and proposed changes to the program. The City is undertaking a comprehensive review of historic preservation incentives in light of the recently approved Historic Preservation Element of the General Plan. The effectiveness of the current Mills Act Program and need for performance requirements are being reviewed. This is the first of two HRB workshops anticipated on this issue. Recommendations for changes to the program are expected to be heard by the City Council this calendar year. Public comment is encouraged. Speakers will be heard following the staff presentation. The Board will discuss the proposed changes and provide comments.
